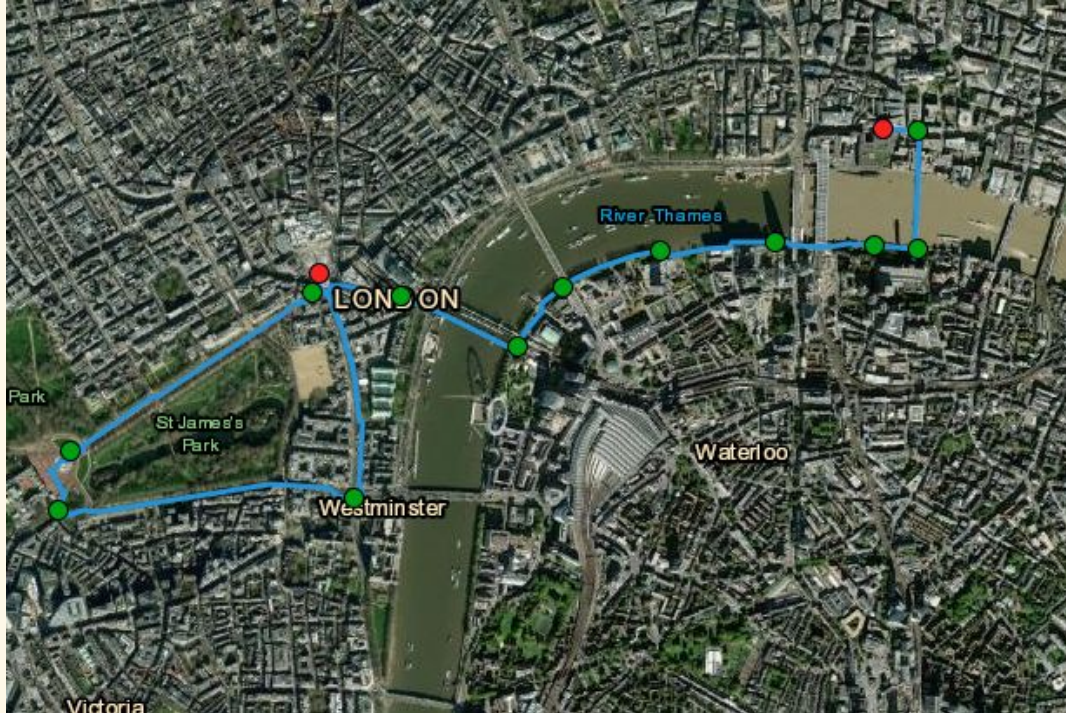

Palace of Westminster

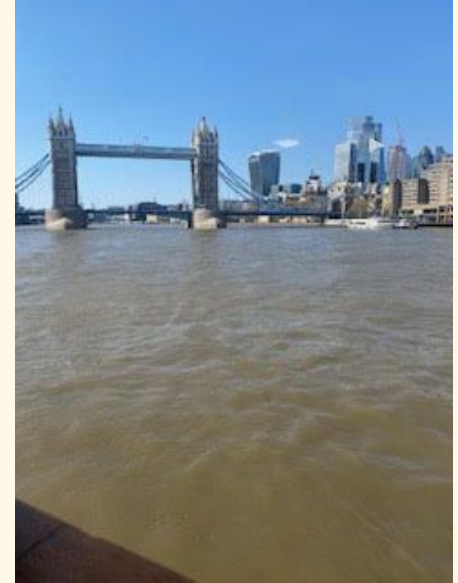


- Formerly known as the Houses of Parliament
