

This means they design social media, apps, games in a way to persuade you to stay using it for longer.




Examples of persuasive design

Autoplay: most streaming services such as Netflix and Disney+ have an autoplay feature that automatically plays the next episode without you having to press play.

Notifications: this can include the banner that appears across the top of the screen, a noise or vibration, and the red bubble all to signal something new.

Examples of persuasive design

Pop Up: a small window that can appear on your screen, even when you haven't done anything. They are mainly used for advertisements, trying to get you to buy something or see something nasty and some of them try to put a virus on your device.

Tips for Striking the Balance





















Tech in Our WorldKey Points
