Years 7 Tassomai for Maths, English and Science

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to have subscribed to 'Tassomai', an online/app-based learning programme that quizzes pupils on their maths, English and science. Pupils will use this as part of their home learning schedule.

The quizzes consist of short multi-choice questions with feedback given instantly as to whether an answer is correct. Over time, Tassomai also adjusts the level of difficulty to the pupil's individual responses. Teachers can see the progress of their class and which aspects of the subject they are struggling with, therefore informing what they do in the classroom. Each set of daily quizzes should take approximately 20 minutes - though they can do more. The children must reach their daily goal each day for each subject.

In Year 7, the children should achieve a minimum of 5 goals in each subject every week from Friday to the following Friday. Tutors will check every Friday and reward for fully completed homework.

In order to access Tassomai for the first time, please follow this link: <https://app.tassomai.com/login>. To log in, pupils must use their school-assigned email address (22lastnamefirstname@allenbournmiddle.org) and the password: SmartWayToStudy. They will then be prompted to choose a new password, which should be the same password they use to access the school computers.

Once pupils have logged on for the first time, they should then continue to use their computer login details 22lastnamefirstname@allenbournmiddle.org and their school password. Please can we ensure that names are spelled correctly.

The pupils should select their classes from the drop down menu if they are not already pre-populated.

After the first login, the free Tassomai App can be downloaded for use on all mobile devices.
