With the Christmas season fast approaching, we are writing to you to tell you about the Year 5 Christmas Bazaar which will take place on Friday 13th December. The Bazaar will take place in the morning - with the stalls being open from 10am until 11.30a.m.

For those of you who are unfamiliar with Christmas at Allenbourn, each year the Year 5 pupils and teachers hold a 'Christmas Bazaar'. The children help organise and run the event, and they love the opportunity to raise funds, run the café, design and play games, see Father Christmas, be Santa's helpers and generally share their hard work with their families and friends.

We are able to receive your kind donations as soon as you wish to send them in. (Food for the café on the day please – in a clearly named container if you want the container returned, please remember we are a nut free school.)

It is always lovely to be able to invite families and friends into school for this event, so make a note in your diary – Friday 13th December, 10am – 11.30 am. (Entrance is free, please enter by the gate next to the school office and walk down towards the doors to the Year 5 area). **The back gate will not be open.**

Last year, the money raised from this event went towards subsidising future Year 5 events.

If we do not see you beforehand, on behalf of the Year 5 team, may we extend a peaceful and merry Christmas to you all. Please remember that the last day of term is Thursday 19th December.
