Sports Days 2026

We are very pleased to announce we will be holding our school Sports Days on Thursday 18th and Friday 19th June.

Children will be taking part in their field events on Thursday 18th June at **Allenbourn and the track events and 'team sports' events, at QE School on Friday 19th June**. Pupils will select their chosen events for both days in the weeks leading up to Sports Day, in house meetings.

For the field events, which include throwing and jumping, pupils will come out in year groups and compete. **Due to safeguarding reasons these events are not open to parents to watch.**

The track and 'team sports' events will take place on **Friday 19th June at QE School**. We would be delighted for you to join us to watch these. This will take place on the lower field (The Broads) from 10.00am onwards and we will aim to be finished by 2.00pm. You are welcome to join us for the day, or just pop in for a short time. Please be aware that there will be **no parking available** at The Broads or Queen Elizabeths School for this event.

We are unable to provide any seating, so please feel free to bring a chair or blanket to sit on and if you wish, a picnic lunch. Please be aware that parents are only able to watch the track events during this time. As a safeguarding measure, the children will not be able to join you for a picnic and will be eating in their house areas. Children will be expected to stay on the inside of the track at all times to ensure their safety during such a large event.

All pupils are asked to come to school wearing the correct AMS PE kit on **both** of the sports days. This should include their PE shirt or a t-shirt in the colour of their house, with their PE shorts/skort and a pair of trainers. As everyone is very aware of the dangers of being outside all day, please can you plan ahead to ensure your child can have with them a high factor sun cream, a hat and plenty of water or suitable layers if the weather is cooler.

The programme for the day will be sent out nearer the time and will also be posted on our school website. Please be aware that all timings provided are approximate.

We really look forward to seeing you on the **19th June** and are excited to be celebrating the day with you and your children. The sports events will be running under the umbrella of the School Games values of Passion, Self-Belief, Respect, Honesty, Determination and Teamwork, alongside our Allenbourn values.
